

Spanish Classes

Wynton's World commitment to high standards also extends to our choice of language schools. Spanish language classes are a major component of the majority of our summer program. Our partner language school is highly regarded and internationally recognized language school. All language teachers are native speakers, have degrees in modern languages and experience teaching Spanish as a foreign language. Classes are limited to usually 10-12 students to enhance the learning environment and encourage as much Spanish conversation as possible. Students are grouped into levels based upon a placement test. Classes are in the morning, Monday through Friday. Generally the classes are divided between two sessions: conversation and grammar. In the grammar section, students study different grammatical structures and their practical applications. In the conversation section, students analyze vocabulary and colloquial expressions.

Activities & Excursions

Wynton's World chaperones supervise a variety of afternoon/evening activities and weekend excursion. Some of our student's favorite activities include:

Language School Homestay

The Homestay portion of the program refers to accommodation with locals in the program town during the weeks that classes take place. Most of these homestay households are within a fifteen-minute walk of the center of the program town and language school in Salamanca. These Spanish-speaking families provide room and board and are carefully chosen for Wynton's World by the language school to provide a safe environment for our students. Students from other countries often share a family with our participants, adding to the international flavor of the homestay experience. Generally, we place two students per home.
